

One More.

Greetings, Friends and Partners!

There has been a particular phrase that has moved my heart over the last year. That phrase is **one more.**

I heard the Gospel at a Tim Hortons in South Western Ontario at the age of 18. One person shared the Gospel and reality of Jesus, and that message transformed my life. I know that the same message changed yours as well. In both yours and my life, someone took the time to share Jesus with us, impacting eternity. We must honour the blood of Jesus and share His Gospel with those in our families, communities and nation. Sharing the Gospel matters.

For the ministry and team of Disciple A City, the phrase **one more** has become a driving theme at every event we host and church we equip to share the Gospel. With Gospel sharing still so low or unprioritized for Canadian churches and believers, we pray and work that one more person who has never heard the Gospel will hear it through a disciple like you.

This phrase of one more depicts the nature of what Disciple A City does and how your partnership with us impacts lives across Canada. In 2024, our team had the joy of equipping

1448 disciples at our events. Our Every Disciple Sent Video Series continues to provide Gospel resources to 886+ people and 97 teams across Canada. Those we have trained have started outreaches for the sole purpose of reaching one more. Since the summer of 2024, an outreach planted in Regina has seen over 25 people give their lives! Another friend took the tools we trained and planted four distinct evangelistic teams in Toronto. Those teams have seen dozens born again and are now being discipled. Truthfully, we currently are witnessing a growing number of believers sharing the Gospel in Canada. Your partnership is fuelling evangelism and discipleship across Canada.

Now, in 2025, our vision is to bring the message of Jesus, the message that transformed your life, to 100,000+ Canadians. We are working with leaders and churches nationwide to facilitate one of the most extensive evangelistic campaigns in 2025 - The 100K Harvest. At the heart of this immersive mission is our prayer, "Father, let us carry the Gospel of Jesus to one more."

Thank you for partnering and praying with us to make Jesus known.

Disciple A City tracks the people we train, the churches we partner with, and the salvations, baptisms and healings that happen through our staff team.

We only track what Disciple A City staff are directly involved in, not what the churches we equip are doing.

Our Every Disciple Sent Video Series has resourced another **886 individuals** and helped plant **97 teams** who share the Gospel in their communities.

In 2024, the Video Series was translated into Spanish and is now being used by the Foursquare denomination for church planting in Costa Rica.

Disciple A City exists to equip every disciple in Canada to share the Gospel and disciple new believers. We recognize the fastest and most effective way to see the nation of Canada impacted by the Gospel is through the mobilization of every church and believer to make Jesus known.

Through our evangelistic training and worship team, we are working with many believers and churches to bring the Gospel to their communities.

Come Together - Regina, SK















"The Disciple A City team was an incredible blessing as collaborators with Gospel Fire For All Nations at our Come Together 2024 event in Regina, Saskatchewan. Leading up to the event, as part of GFFAN's efforts to serve the pastors of Saskatchewan, Disciple A City sent teams to three cities to train and equip partnering churches in one-to-one evangelism. GFFAN gathered over 400 volunteers for the 2 day Gospel event, and Disciple A City helped to train over 100 of those volunteers to serve on the Altar Ministry Team where a multitude of miracles broke out! They also took dozens of volunteers out to do evangelism during the event. The Come Together event saw over 1000 salvations! We are grateful for Disciple A City's collaboration to see souls saved in Canada and every disciple following Jesus to seek and save the lost."


For the Year Ended December 31, 2024

A GOD-SIZED VISION


Disciple A City has a God-sized vision to reach over 100,000 Canadians with a face-to-face Gospel interaction in 2025.

We are inviting 200+ teams or churches to join us in bringing the Gospel to 500+ people in 2025.

The main push of this campaign will happen between June and November of 2025. Canadian leaders across the nation will be hosting evangelistic blitz days where believers will gather and be sent to share Jesus in every province in Canada.

This vision is partnered with multiple ministries across Canada and will conclude with an evangelistic conference in Ontario.


